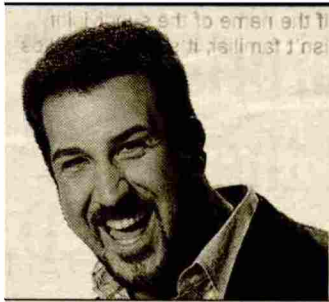


## TONIGHT
